The original pattern is approximately 13" x 11" but you can make it any size you'd like. It can be put on anything. Box, notecards. Whatever you have in your stash of fun things to paint on! If you would a birch plywood surface cut out of the pattern you can contact Dianne. The price will be \$12.

Zen Snowmen Preparation: Base coat entire surface with white. Repeat for opaque coverage. Trace and transfer the pattern.

Paint need at class: White / burnt sienna / black / burnt umber / slate grey / tangelo orange

Supplies: The usual brushes, micron pigment pens 02 or 03. The willingness to do this cute project. :)

BRUSH BENDER'S General Meeting July 22, 2013


